This Contract for Semen Collection, Mare Care and Artificial Insemination is made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2006, by and between _____, ("Mare Owner"), and Christine Grieco ("Breeder"), Four Legged Farms Stallion Station ("Breeding Facility"). Breeder agrees to ship Cooled Semen collected from **JC Montanasamigo**, Homozygous for both Tobiano and Black genes, a 2001 APHA Stallion, APHA Registration No. 639,918 (the "Stallion") and nominated to the APHA 2004 Breeder's Trust, for Artificial Insemination of the Mare _____, Registration No _____ (the "Mare"), subject to the following terms and conditions:

BREEDING FEES

The Breeding Fee for Stallion is \$800.00, of which 400.00 shall be payable at the time of the execution of this Contract as a Booking Fee. Said Booking Fee serves as a non-refundable Deposit. Other fees/expenses incurred in connection with the shipment of Cooled Semen are set forth below and shall be paid in full prior to shipment:

Breeding Fee Balance	\$400.00
1 st Collection/Shipping/Container Fee	Included

Collection days for Cooled Semen shall be Monday, Wednesday and Friday Mornings only for same day Artificial Insemination of the Mare breeding at Four Legged Farms, subject to having a finalized breeding agreement in place and all required fees having been paid in full.

Cancellations for Artificial Insemination must be made by 7:00am EST; cancellations made after that will incur a \$150.00 service fee. **All requests for Semen, cancellations and inquiries regarding shipments should be directed to Four Legged Farms**

Dr Greg Wolf is our attending veterinarian. His fees for normal services and procedures during breeding season are at the expense of the Mare owner and invoiced separately.

Additional Collection and shipments, if required, shall be \$200.00 each. Personal checks in payment of the breeding fee balance, collection, shipping and container fee must be received by us 10 days prior to shipment. Cashier or Certified Checks will receive immediate credit.

REQUIRED MARE BREEDING DOCUMENTATION

The following documentation shall be delivered to Breeder at the time this Contract is executed:

A copy of Mare's Registration papers (both sides)

A veterinarian's health certificate including: uterine culture, worming, immunization records and current on all vaccinations including VEWT, Flu Rhino.

A current (within six months) Negative Coggins test document.

If these documents are not presented upon Mare's arrival, Breeding Facility shall have the attending veterinarian make proper tests and evaluations at Mare Owner's expense. The Breeding Facility requires 24 hour notice of Mare's arrival, so please call and schedule a time to deliver your Mare.

Mare Owner shall agree that the Mare offered for breeding shall be in sound breeding condition and free from infection or disease. Any mare certified by the attending veterinarian not to be, in his opinion, in sound breeding condition, shall not be bred and Mare Owner may substitute another mare within that breeding season. Mare must be halter broke and manageable.

Breeding Facility will exercise judgment consistent with recognized standards in the care and supervision of Mare and/or any accompanying foals and will arrange for veterinarian and farrier services as necessary for the health and safety of the Mare and/or any accompanying foal. All veterinary and farrier expenses will be paid by the Mare Owner.

Neither Breeder nor the Breeding Facility shall be liable for injury, sickness or the death of the Mare and/or accompanying foal, regardless of how it may occur.

MARE CARE

Proper notification shall be defined as written certification by a licensed veterinarian within seven (7) days from the date Mare is proved not to be in foal or loses her foal as set forth above and Mare Owner must certify that such abortion or death did not result from any act or omission of the Mare Owner subsequent to the Mare's departure from Breeding Facility. Failure to provide notification as set forth above shall void the Live Foal Guarantee. The Live Foal Guarantee shall be void if Mare is abused, participates in a race, race training or a racing event, or otherwise participates in hazardous activity after being pronounced safe in foal. Booster rhino pneumonitis vaccinations must be administered as indicated by the Mare Owner's veterinarian as the Mare progresses through her pregnancy. Failure to do this will void the Live Foal Guarantee. Live Foal Guarantee applies only if Mare is checked in foal by a licensed veterinarian and Mare Owner further understands and agrees that there will be no guarantee of a live foal if Mare leaves Breeding Facility on or before being checked safe in foal by the attending veterinarian. Mare Owner understands and agrees that neither Breeder nor Breeding Facility shall be held liable for the loss, abortion or death of said foal.

Waiver of Liability is understood that neither Breeder nor Breeding Facility, its owners, employees and/or guests shall be liable for any injury, escape, disability or death of Mare and/or her

accompanying foal or any other horses on the premises of Breeding Facility. The above named Mare Owner whose horse(s) are under the care of Breeding Facility will not be liable or responsible for any damage, injury or death to the Breeder's Stallion, the Breeding Facility's employees or any other animals owned by or in the care of Breeding Facility, whether or not caused by Mare Owner's horse(s).

Mare Care shall be \$18.00 Per Day Dry
\$13.00 Per Day Pasture

Mare Care expenses will be due and payable at the time said Mare leaves the Breeding Facility. Breeding Facility requires 48 hours advance notice when Mare Owner wishes to remove his/her Mare to provide sufficient time for the Breeding Facility to prepare the final statement so Mare Owner may settle his/her account. The Mare will not be released to the Mare Owner or his/her representative until all fees are paid in full. **All Mare Care fees and expenses shall be payable to "Four Legged Farms".**

LIVE FOAL GUARANTEE

Live Foal shall be defined as a foal that shall stand and nurse without assistance and survive the first 24 hours. If the Mare aborts her foal, the foal is stillborn or said foal does not survive longer than 24 hours, a return season will be guaranteed for the following year only provided proper notification is given to Breeder of the loss.

Proper notification shall be defined as written certification by a licensed veterinarian within seven (7) days from the date the Mare is proved not to be in foal or loses her foal as set forth above and the Mare Owner must certify that such abortion or death did not result from any act or omission of the Mare Owner. Failure to provide notification as set forth above shall void the Live Foal Guarantee.

The Live Foal Guarantee shall be void if the Mare is abused, participates in a race, race training or a racing event, or otherwise participates in hazardous activity after being pronounced safe in foal.

Booster rhino pneumonitis vaccinations must be administered as indicated by the Mare Owner's veterinarian as the Mare progresses through her pregnancy. Failure to do this will void the Live Foal Guarantee.

Mare owner must furnish a veterinary certificate confirming that Mare is in foal as a result of the Cooled Semen insemination within 60 days post breeding. Failure to notify Breeder within 60 days will void the Live Foal Guarantee.

Mare Owner understands and agrees that neither the Breeder nor Breeding Facility shall be held liable for the loss, abortion or death of said foal.

COLOR GUARANTEE

Breeder guarantees that the foal shall have sufficient color to be registered in the APHA Regular Registry in accordance with the APHA color requirements. If, under APHA color requirements the breeding results in a breeding stock foal, the Mare Owner will be entitled to a return privilege with the same Mare, or an approved substitute, the following season only.

BREEDERS CERTIFICATE

A Breeders Certificate shall be issued to Mare Owner only after Mare Owner has notified Breeder that said Mare has produced a live foal and only after payment of all bills due on said Mare has been received.

MISCELLANEOUS

The breeding season in force for this Contract shall begin January 15 and close June 30th of the year covered by this Contract.

It is further agreed that should the above-named Stallion die or become unfit for service, or if the above-named Mare dies during the breeding season, then Mare Owner may substitute another mare or breed the above-named Mare to another Stallion that is agreed to by both the Mare Owner and Breeder.

This Contract shall not be transferable by the Mare Owner without the prior written consent of Breeder.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties; any amendments to or modifications of the terms of this Agreement must be in writing. This Contract is entered into, and shall be interpreted and enforced under, the laws of the State of Florida. Should it be necessary for Breeder to employ an attorney to enforce any of the terms of this Agreement, including collection of money owed, the Mare Owner shall pay all reasonable attorneys' fees, costs of suit and other expenses reasonably related to enforcing this Agreement.
